New Volleyball Standards : Angie Kollbaum presented one bid of \$2800 that included poles, ladder/umpire stand, padding, and net. Current set up has been repaired numerous times and is in need again. Additional bids are needed and Randy Harms moved to table to a later meeting.

Replacement of desks in the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade room. Many of the current desks are 50+ years old and repair is no longer possible. We have 5 usable desks in storage. Motion was made by Rachel Weinberg to purchase 20 desks and 24 chairs. Sharon Logan 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion was carried. Aprox.cost \$3000.

### EVENING SPEAKER

### OTHER DISCUSSION
