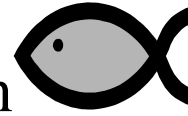

Dear Parents,
The next few weeks are going to be pretty busy! Remember that your child still needs lots of sleep and a good breakfast every morning!

Spelling The groups have been reorganized. We have one group of 2nd graders, one group of 1st graders, and one group that has both! You will find the planned spelling lists for all three groups on the back of this note!

1st Grade Some are reading stories from the textbook, Dream a Story; others have gone on to the book, Bears Don't Go to School, as well as "baggy books." Every child still needs to read at least 15 minutes every night in either their reading books or baggy books!

2nd Grade Reading Some children still need to practice the story, "Seeing." Some still need to practice the story, "Furry Mouse." All of the children need to practice reading "Two Mice," starting on page 216 in their reading text

book. Please note that nightly reading is expected and required! You should have a December "Book It" calendar to record your child's nightly reading. If you did not get one, let me know.

Math 2nd graders will be learning about adding 2 digit numbers with regrouping. Wednesday's homework may be done at school. Expect a math test on Friday.

Science/Social Studies We are working on the Christmas program music. Also, we will work on Christmas arts and crafts.

Religion We will learn more about the events leading up to Christ's nativity.
