Betty Harms and Becky Kaiser work at the concession stand which is sponsored by the P.I.E. during the home games.



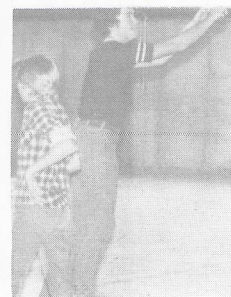
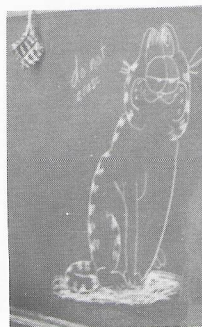
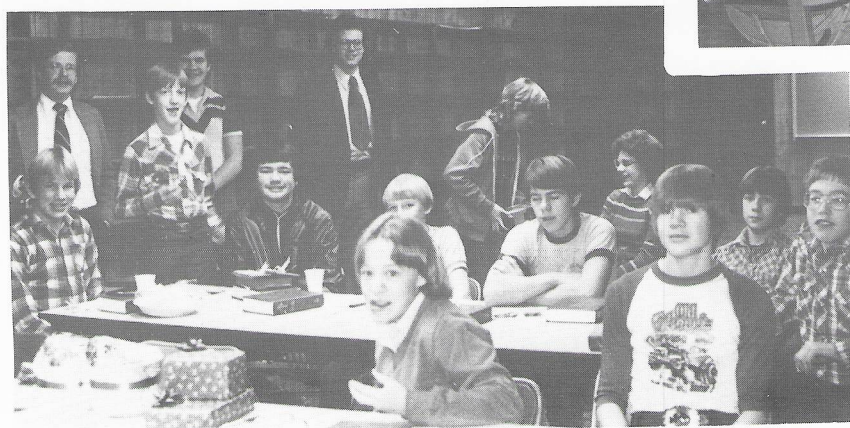
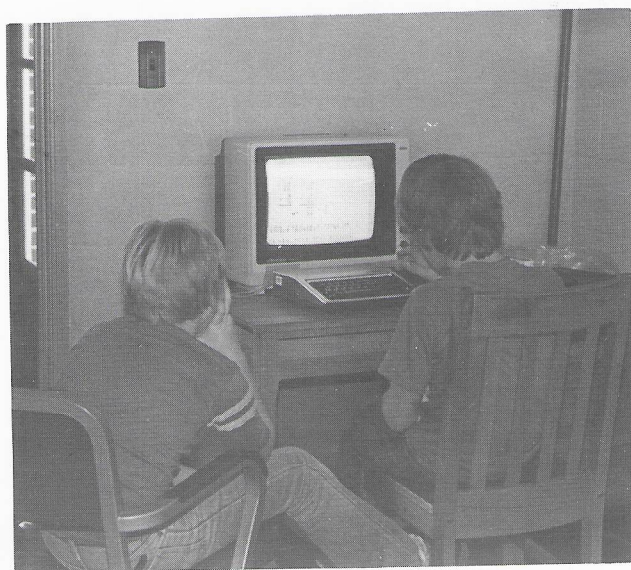
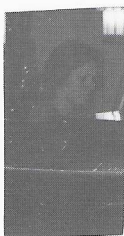
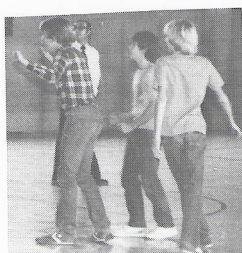
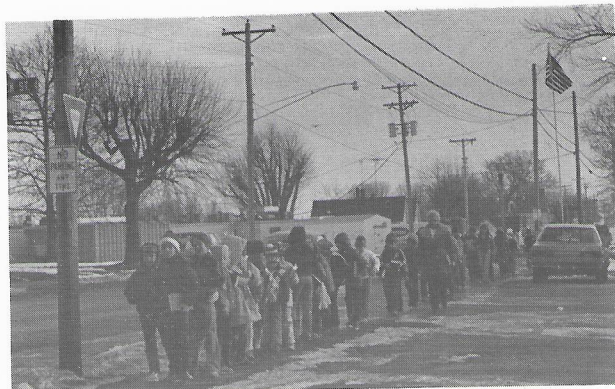
