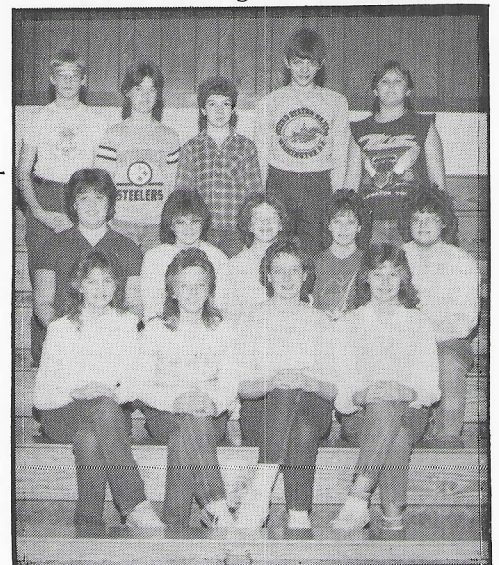
So it was on to Arizona for us. We located Jodi and since she and Tammy Eckhoff are best friends, she knew that Tammy was a "Rock-ett" in New York.

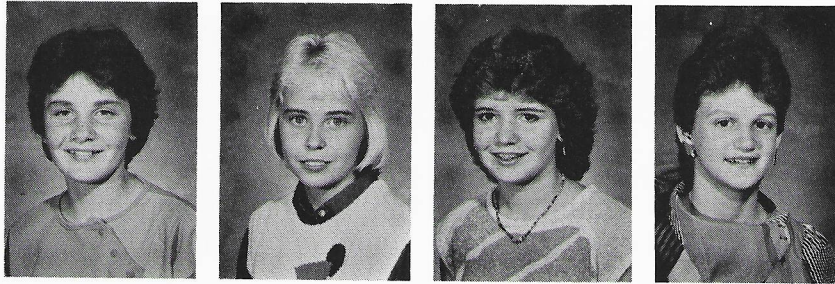
We knew the only place for Ronnie Schnakenberg to be was in the Army. And sure enough, we found him at Fort Knox.

Everyone returned to Cole Camp and had a big party with the money that Mr. Bauer gave us for our successful search.

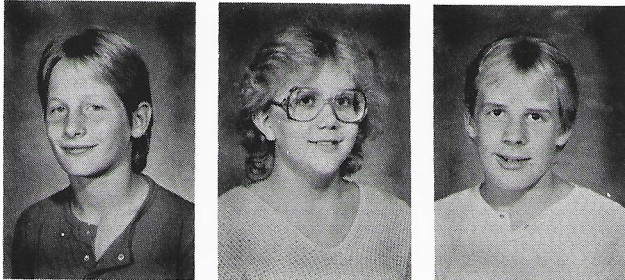

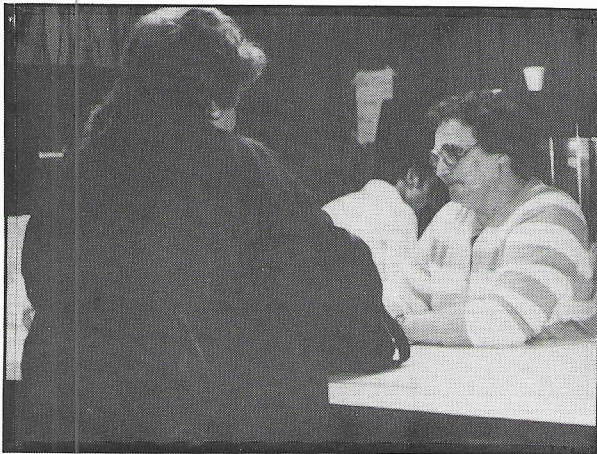
The five P.I.E. meetings of the school year have topics of interest, entertainment by the students and they give us the opportunity to worship together as an organization.
