

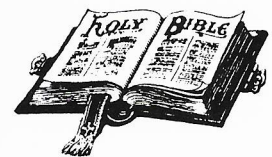
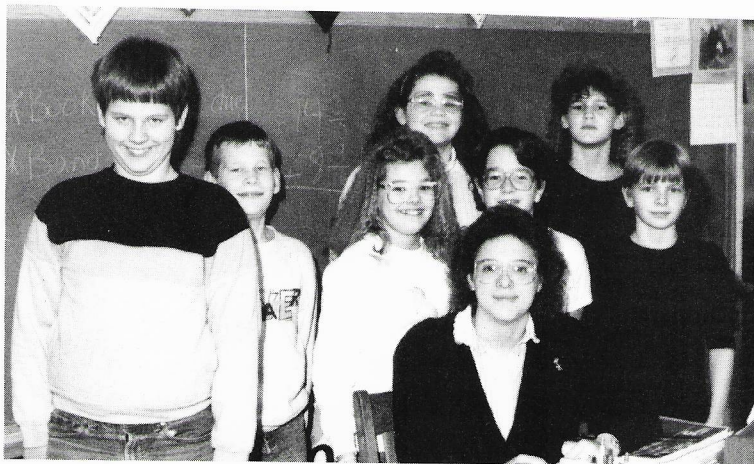
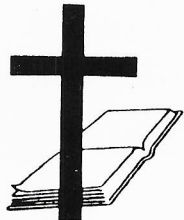
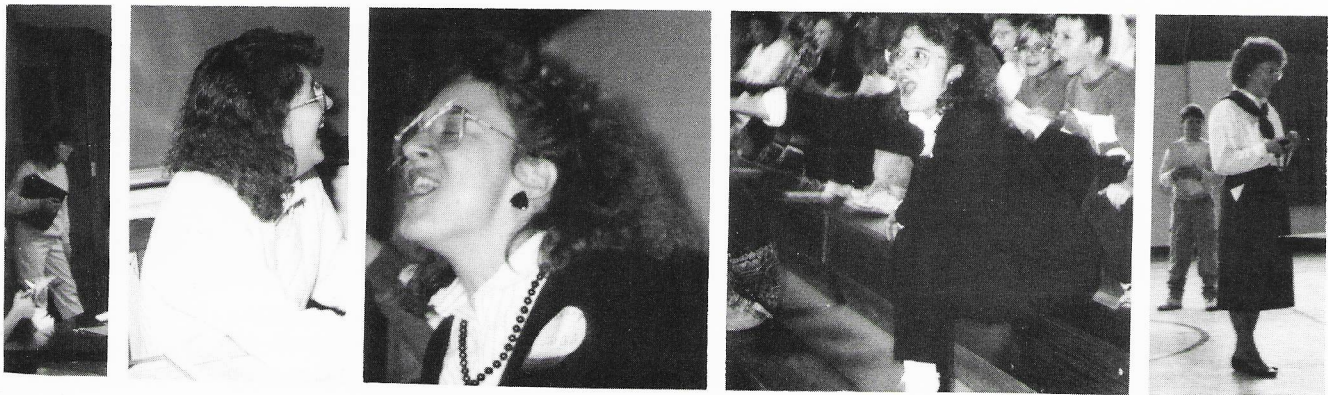
Dedication
