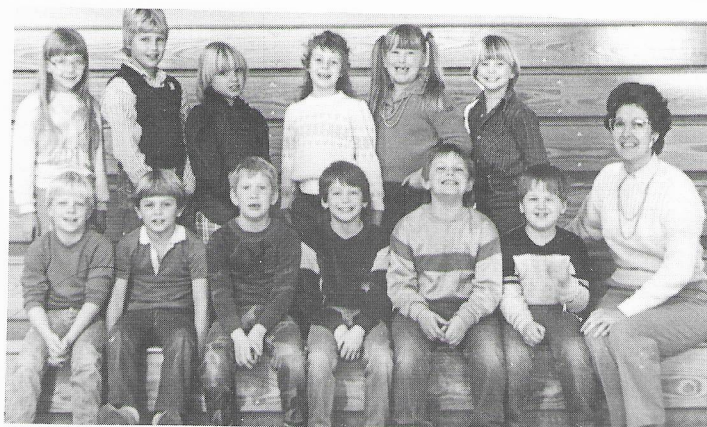


Dedication

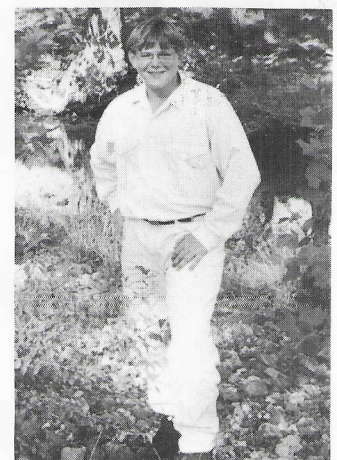
While visiting Kevin we ran into Christel Weinberg who is an Elvis impersonator, performing in Boston. Then we flew home to Kansas City.
