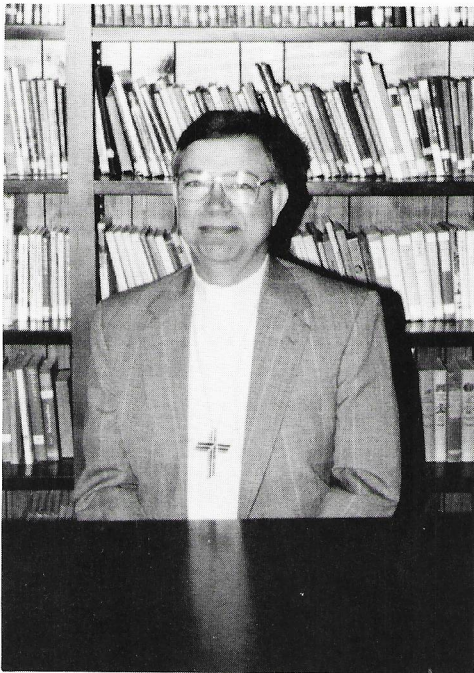
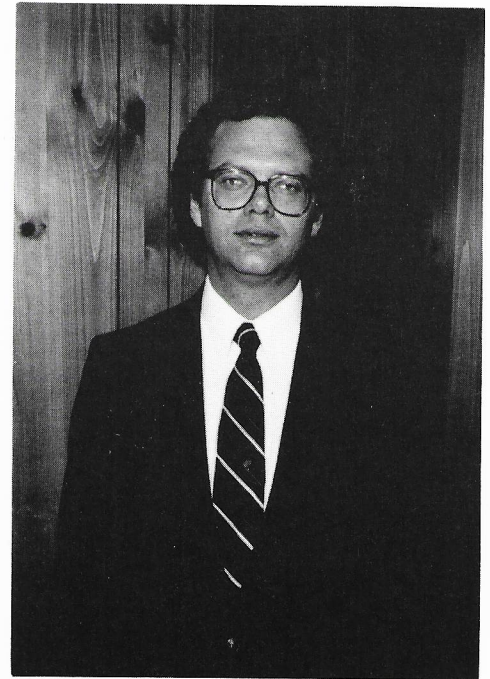


DEDICATIONS

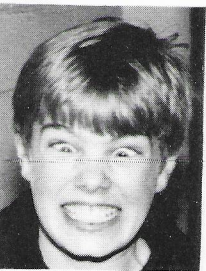
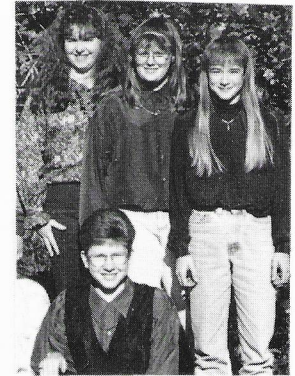
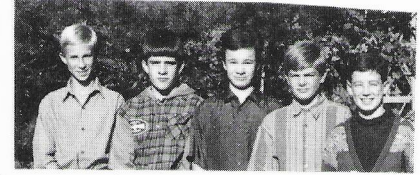
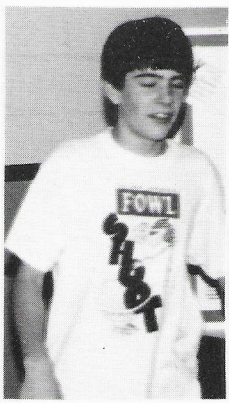
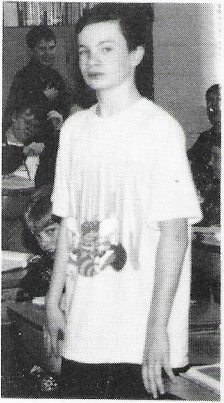
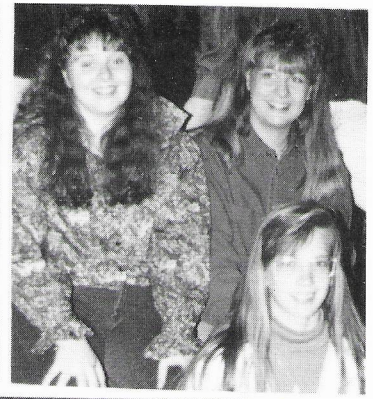
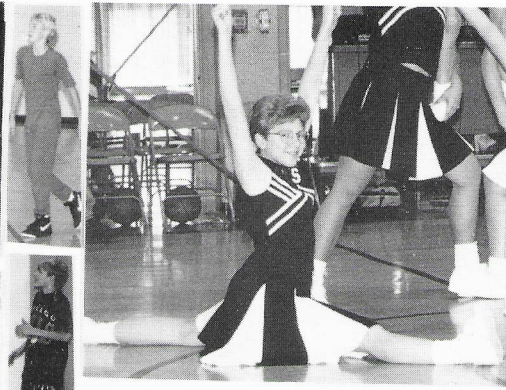
We flew to New York to see Andrew and Reba on Erin's show. After the show was over we were talking to Erin and we found out that Heather Goosen was the producer.

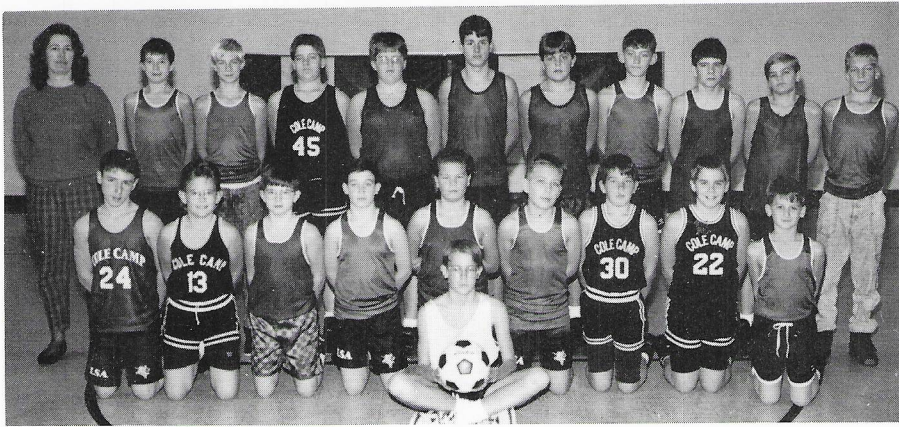
